

All Natural Treatment for Cold Sores Protocol

If you are currently on anti-viral medicine such as Abreva, Valtrax or Acyclovir, you will be required to discontinue use to take part in this study.

Goals:

This study is designed to evaluate prevention and treatment of cold sores. This study will:

1. Assess the efficacy of an all natural medication for the treatment of an active cold sore.
2. Assess the efficacy of daily use of product in the prevention of cold sores

Enrollment:

All patients who experience recurring cold sores with a frequency of 2 or more every 12 weeks.

Instructions:

Apply as you would if you were applying a lip balm or Chap Stick®.

Apply minimally once daily or in a form and fashion as if this product was only for use to treat dry and chapped lips.

Apply when a cold sore outbreak is eminent (prodromal stage) or has occurred (presence of redness, swelling and blistering), apply minimally 3X daily.

Patient Assessment:

Please see the Clinical Form. The key to success is daily use and assessment of pain and inflammation. You will submit the clinical form on the last day of your treatment.
